Who's Your One? is an initiative meant to encourage everyday people to share Jesus with at least one person this year. The North American Mission Board has a 40-Day Devotional app [here](#) to walk you through 40 days of intentional prayer to help you provide encouragement for someone who needs the hope of the gospel. Prayer guides for the 30 days of prayer that we will start on September 1 are also available in the Breezeway and in Sunday School classrooms. If every person in the church will pray for and share the Gospel with just one person, what a difference it will make in our church, and in our community!

From the Pastor's Desk



What is church about? Why is it important?

Honestly, I think in the process of doing church we can easily lose our focus on what it is really all about. We then substitute our own ideas for God's true purpose.

It doesn't matter how many churches we have tried, or joined. How many sermons we have sat through, or committees we have sat on, or dollars we have contributed. Church is not about buildings, or budgets, or pot-luck meals. It is about doing everything we can so that lost men, women, and children will have a life-changing experience of trusting God. Church is about letting God work in and through us, not because He needs us, but because He has chosen to bless us with the privilege of being used by Him to change others for His glory.

When you think of someone who is far from God, who first comes to your mind? Is it a family member? Is it someone with whom you work? Is it a friend? Is it a neighbor? No matter who it is that first comes to your mind, do you realize that God wants to use you to reach them? If you are willing, He can use you. For that reason, starting September 1, Zion Hill, in partnership with the North American Mission Board of the Southern Baptist Convention, and with the North Pulaski Baptist Association, will make available to you a 30-day prayer guide. We are asking everyone in the church to be a part. The guide will have a short Bible study each day that will focus our attention on reaching people for whom Christ gave His life. Who is your one?

Then, on Sunday, September 29, at 10:55, a time of Revival will start. Brian Arnold will be with us in concert that morning. The Music Leader each night will be Michael Tollett from North Hills Baptist Church. We will have a different pastor from our North Pulaski Baptist Association bring the message each night. Sunday School classes have signed up to provide a meal each night from 6:00-6:30.

Here is a little information about the choices you have:

Baptist Adults – This is the primary Southern Baptist literature for discipleship. This literature will be an option every time we sign up for new studies as its subject matter is constantly changing. For our first study session the subjects covered will be: "What Christians Believe about Salvation" and "Witnessing to Win."

Share Jesus Without Fear – Ever wish you had an easy way to express to others the joy you've found in Christ? Ever regret not sharing the simple Truths because you were afraid?
