The Sermon Series: Jesus — The Ultimate Action Hero

Church family,

Here's a question for you: Why do we love superhero movies?

March is here. And I'm not gonna sugarcoat it — this might be the most important month on our church calendar this year.

Because something deep inside every one of us is looking for a Savior. Every hero story humanity has ever told — the rescue, the sacrifice, the victory — is just an echo of the one true Hero who actually lived, actually died, and actually walked out of a grave.

Everything we do in March is aimed at one thing: Easter Sunday, April 5th. Every sermon, every event, every text you receive at 6:00 AM — all of it is building toward the moment we celebrate the fact that Jesus Christ walked out of a tomb and changed everything.

This series isn't about superheroes. It's about Jesus. We're using the heroes your neighbors already love to open a door — and then we're showing them the One standing on the other side.

So buckle up. Here's what's coming.

Here's the lineup:

- **March 1 — "Stronger Than Superman"** (Mark 4:35-41) — Superman is fiction. Jesus speaks and creation obeys. That's real power.
- **March 8 — "The Hero Next Door"** (Luke 19:1-10) — Spider-Man helps the little guy. Jesus sees you — by name, one at a time.
- **March 15- "Into the Darkness"** (Mark 5:1-20)-Batman goes where it's dark. Jesus walks into the places everyone else has given up on and sets captives free.
- **March 22- "The Hero Who Never Quits"** (Matthew 26:36-46)- Captain America gets back up every time. Jesus sweat blood in the garden- and still chose you.
- **March 29 — "The Hero Who Laid It All Down"** (John 19:16-30) — Iron Man snapped his fingers. Jesus carried a cross. Only one of those is real.

Every week, the superheroes get smaller. Jesus gets bigger. By Easter, every fictional cape and mask falls away, and only the risen Christ is left standing.

Here's what I need from you: Bring somebody. Seriously. You know someone who would never walk into a church on a normal Sunday — but they might walk in for this. Invite them. Text them. Drag them if you have to. This series is built for the person who's never heard the real story.

INVITE SOMEONE!

The 33-Day "Know and Follow Jesus" Challenge

Starting March 4th, we're launching a daily text challenge that will take you face-to-face with the real Jesus — not a stained-glass figure, not a fictional hero — the actual Son of God as He's revealed in Scripture.

Every morning at 6:00 AM, you'll get a text with a short devotional — about 15 to 20 minutes. A Gospel passage. A short teaching. And one concrete step to follow Jesus that day.

Four weeks. Four themes:

1. **Who Is Jesus?** — His identity, authority, and heart
2. **How Does Jesus Save?** — His mission to seek, rescue, and restore
3. **What Did Jesus Teach?** — His words that change everything
4. **How Do I Follow Jesus?** — Daily, practical discipleship

By Easter Sunday, you'll have spent an entire month walking with Jesus through the Gospels. And you'll be ready to answer the question that matters most: "Who is He to you?"

Kids & Family Ministry — Y'all, This Is Going to Be Fun

If you've got kids or grandkids, listen up. Our children's ministry team is going all out this month. Every single Sunday has a theme, and your kids are going to be begging to come back.

- 🦸 March 1 — Superhero Sunday — Kids come dressed as their favorite superhero. We'll show them the real one.
- 🔍 **March 8 — Scavenger Hunt Sunday** — Bible-clue scavenger hunt through the building. Final clue? Luke 19:10.
- 🦇 **March 15 — Glow in the Dark Party** (Extended 9:30 AM event!) — A high-energy glow experience inspired by Batman and themed "Into the Darkness." Black lights, neon games, and interactive Bible moments will show kids that while Batman faces fictional darkness, Jesus steps into real darkness and brings freedom. This one starts early — drop the kids off at 9:30.
- 🏃 **March 22 — Obstacle Course Sunday** — School's out, energy is high. Let 'em run. Every station ties to a moment Jesus could have quit but didn't.
- ✝️ **March 29 — Grace Sunday** — A reflective, cross-centered experience. Kids write what Jesus gave up for them and place it at the foot of a wooden cross.
- 🐣 **April 5 — Miracle of Easter Celebration** — A Christmas-style celebration filled with joy, music, and Gospel focus on the empty tomb. We'll highlight the miracle: Jesus died, was buried, and rose again — and because He lives, we have hope. Start of MOE (Miracle of Easter) at (9:15), Service (10:30), Egg Hunt (11:45).

Parents — March 15 Is for You Too

While the kids are running Spy Sunday at 9:30 AM, we're hosting a special Parent Preview Class: "When Your Kids Face the Dark Stuff." This isn't a repeat of the sermon. It's a deep-dive on how to

apply Mark 5 directly to parenting — helping your kids face fear, darkness, and the hard stuff with faith. Coffee, donuts, and real talk. Don't miss it.

Stitching with Love Ministry Meets the first Thursday of each month at 9AM

We would love to have you join us!

The *Stitching with Love* Ministry meets on the first Thursday of each month in the fellowship hall for a time of fellowship and service.

Volunteers bring their portable sewing machines, fabric, scissors, tape measures—and of course an array of snacks for lunch—and set up a mini workshop where they work together to create handmade items for those in need.

Each month, the group makes over a hundred care caps for cancer patients that are distributed to UAMS and CARTI in Little Rock,

North Little Rock and Searcy. They also produce approximately 100 seatbelt pads for patients undergoing treatment.

In addition, the ministry creates baby blankets with matching bibs and burp cloths, along with extra bibs, baby caps, and small teddy bears. Many of these baby items are donated to Options Pregnancy Center to support local families.

As the spring months arrive, it would be a perfect time to dedicate some time to serving those in need. No sewing experience is required—there are always opportunities to help with ironing, cutting, or organizing materials. All are welcome to participate!

They meet on the first Thursday of each month, and this month they will be meeting on March 5 at 9AM in the fellowship hall.

MARCH 22ND SPRING BREAK BASH


